K. Meizter is known as being one half of Beyond Sensory Experiences, but also as the enigmatic scientist behind his solo-project. "Dark matters" is a quite diversified piece of music where ambient parts and pure industrial drones are constantly crossing each other. The ambient parts are more mysterious than dark, like a feeling you can't really explain, but in a way comparable to some movies of David Lynch. The track "A passage" is probably the most icy piece from the list and still one of the absolute high lights, but it's just a pity that it's so short. When cold- and mysterious elements are coming together you get the cool "Sidelights on the life of death" and in a definitely more explicit ambient style "Internal features of a dead body" is getting the gold.
