Ratan is the third and final part of the 2003 trilogy released on Old Europa Café by the Swedish duo Beyond Sensory Experience (BSE). With Ratan Beyond Sensory Experience finalizes the path set out during the predecessors Urmula (OECD 059) and Tortuna (OECD 049).

The sound of Beyond Sensory Experience and Ratan in particular travels from dark subtle soundscapes to monumental orchestral pieces via experimental detours to unexplored electronic territory producing conspicuous music for the mind.
